

## **Well Service Rig Manager**

The candidate has worked their way up through Floorhand, Derrickhand, and Operator positions to become acquainted with the equipment and well servicing procedures. The Rig Manager manages the overall operation of the rig.

- Staying in communication with the Field Supervisor
- Managing all of the activities on the location about the rig, crew and the equipment
- Acting as liaison between the service rig company and the oil company
- Communicating with the oil company representative to determine the courses of action on the well
- Ensuring proper and timely maintenance of the rig equipment
- Assigning work to the rig crew members
- Holding and giving guidance to the daily safety meetings
- Ensuring compliance with government, oil company and rig company regulations, policies and practices
- Organizing the moving of the rig and equipment
- Keeping all records up to date
- Maintaining all documentation on a daily and monthly basis
- Supervising the physical activities of the crew to ensure proper safe working practices
- Responding to the requests of the Operations Manager and the Field Supervisor
